RESOLUTION NO. 19-148 OF 2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORRISTOWN, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO APPROVE THE INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (“PENNDOT”) FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADES (“TSU”), CLOSED-CIRCUIT VIDEO CAMERAS (“CCTV”), AND TRAVEL TIME READERS (“TTR”) AT VARIOUS LOCATION(S) ALONG STATE ROUTE 0202, SECTION 61S.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Norristown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania (the “Municipality”) is a Home Rule Municipality, which Home Rule Charter authorizes Council to enter into contracts from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting through its Department of Transportation (“PennDOT”) intends to make certain improvements to and perform certain construction on State Route 0202, Section 61S, (the “Project”) that will include the need for electrical and communication cable, traffic signal upgrades (“TSU”), closed-circuit video cameras (“CCTV”), and travel time readers (“TTR”) at various location(s) within the Project area; and

WHEREAS, the cost of installing electrical and communication cable, TSU, CCTV, and TTR at these locations is being partially or totally funded with Commonwealth or federal funds or a combination of both; and

WHEREAS, PennDOT has requested that the Municipality enter into an agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A.” titled “Intelligent Transportation Systems Cooperative Agreement” that the respective functions and responsibilities of both the Municipality and the Commonwealth with respect to the installation, maintenance, and financing of the electrical and communication cable, TSU, CCTV, and TTR;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Members of Council of the Municipality of Norristown, that that the Municipality is authorized to enter into “Intelligent Transportation Systems Cooperative Agreement” with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation as attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and be it further resolved that the Municipal Administrator is authorized to take all action to effectuate the execution of the agreement or related documents.
