**ORDINANCE NO. 20-08 of 2020**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORRISTOWN,  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING THE FISCAL  
YEAR 2020 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ACTION PLAN  
AND COVID-19 EMERGENCY FUNDING PROPOSED BUDGETS**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Norristown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania (the "Municipality") is an entitlement community under the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by Norristown Municipal Council, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

**SECTION I. BUDGET ADOPTION**

The detailed budget prepared by the Municipal Administration and on file with the Municipal Administrator setting forth the projected projects and projected revenues and expenditures for the Municipality of Norristown Community Development Block Grant Program for the 2020 Fiscal Year and the COVID-19 CDBG Emergency Funding budgets are hereby summarized, adopted and approved as follows:

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

1. HOUSING PROJECTS	\$ 120,000
2. MUNICIPAL PROJECTS	\$ 584,575
3. ADMINISTRATION	\$ 160,000
TOTAL	\$ 864,275

COVID-19 Community Development Block (CDBG)

1. ASSISTANCE TO BUSINESSES	\$300,000
2. PUBLIC SERVICES	\$158,433
3. ADMINISTRATION	\$ 50,000
TOTAL	\$508,433

**SECTION II. ADMINISTRATION OF GRANT**

The Municipal Council of the Municipality of Norristown authorized the Administration to administer the Community Development Block Grant Program and the COVID-19 Community Development Block Grant in accordance with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations under such terms and conditions to comply with Federal guidelines and are otherwise in the best interests of the Municipality.

**SECTION III. REPEALER**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION IV. SAVINGS CLAUSE**

Should any part or parts of this ordinance be found to be void by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full effect.
